



**Public Tender No. 91-24/19**  
**Sale and supply of products sold over the counter (OTC)**  
**under the private label of Clalit Health Services**

1. Clalit Health Services ("Clalit") hereby invites price proposals for an engagement relating to the sale and supply to Clalit of products sold under Clalit's private label over the counter (OTC), without the need for a doctor's prescription, at pharmacies and other points of sale of Clalit ("The Products"). Subject to the provisions of any applicable law, Clalit will examine expanding the engagement and purchase of the Products for its hospitals as well.
2. Products include: Thermometer, gauze pad, bandage, adhesive pad, elastic bandage, alcohol pad, cotton wool, band-aid, hot water bottle, heating cushion, human scale, and first aid kit.
3. Products are divided into "Products Groups" as described below (and as described in greater detail in the tender documents). Bids can be submitted for one or more Products Groups. A bid for any Products Group must include all Products within the same Products Group. A condition for submitting a bid to any Products Group is compliance with the required annual sales turnover, as detailed below:

4. A condition for the submission of a bid by an Israeli bidder is the existence of all the approvals and affidavits required under the Public Entities Transactions Law, 1976.
5. Products will be supplied to Clalit's logistic center in Shoham (Israel). In spite of the above, the supply of the Products by foreign (non-Israeli) suppliers will be under CIP terms, Ashdod port (Israel), and Clalit will be responsible for customs release and land transportation to the logistics center in Shoham, due to these additional costs. Of foreign offer. Due to these additional costs, a surcharge of 3% will be added to the price proposals of foreign bidders.
6. The Tenders Committee intends to conduct an additional (Best & Final) stage between 3 bidder with the lowest price proposal in each Products Group. Clalit does not undertake to accept the lowest bid or any bid.
7. The engagement by virtue of the tender is for a period of 60 months. However, Clalit may terminate the engagement (early termination) at the end of 24, 36 or 48 months.
8. The Engagement with the Winning Bidder will constitute a framework agreement. Clalit shall issue purchase orders for the Products from time to time at Clalit's discretion, and in accordance with its needs. Clalit does not undertake to purchase any minimum quantities.
9. The contents of this notice constitute a brief description of some of the terms of the Tender. Each bidder is required to check all terms of engagement detailed in the Tender documents, which can be downloaded (free of charge) from Clalit's website at: [www.clalit.org.il](http://www.clalit.org.il). This website may also periodically contain Tender updates.
10. Last date for submission of requests for clarifications is **March 3th, 2019** at 12:00 (Israel time - GMT+2).
11. Bids are to be submitted via Clalit's Sourcing Vision System (only online submission; no physical paper), as specified in the Tender Documents. Last date for submission of bids is March 25th, 2019 at 12:00 (Israel time - GMT+2).
12. This notice constitutes part of the Tender Documents. Nothing stated in this notice shall derogate from the conditions specified in the Tender Documents.
