TWO-PHASE TENDER WITH AN ADDITIONAL
COMPETITIVE PROCESS**

1. Clalit Health Services (hereinafter: "Clalit") is interested in receiving price quotations for new hospital patient cabinets (hereinafter: the "Cabinets") under all the terms and requirements detailed in the tender documents.
2. For the purpose of this tender, the Cabinets have been divided into 2 professional categories, as set forth below:
 - 2.1. **Patient Cabinet type I** (as set forth in **Appendix G**- General demands from hospital Patient Cabinets).
 - 2.2. **Patient Cabinet type II** (as set forth in **Appendix G**- General demands from hospital Patient Cabinets).
3. For each group, it is possible to submit a price proposal solely and only for your models of Cabinets that meet all the requirements as detailed in **Appendix G**.
4. Each bidder must meet the following requirements, which are thresholds to its participation in the tender: The manufacturer of the bidder's proposed cabinets sold during the years 2013-2015 at least 600 cabinets in total.
5. By virtue of this tender, the contract is for a period of 48 (forty eight) months, which shall commence on the start date as shall be determined by Clalit and the bidders shall be notified as regards the results of the tender
6. The bidder will be responsible for checking the conditions of the tender, including any information and terms of engagement and all other relevant information. For the avoidance of doubt, the terms set forth in this announcement are the essence of the conditions for participation in the tender. All other terms and conditions detailed at length in the tender's documents.
7. This announcement is inseparable of the tender's documents and not derogate from the terms and conditions of the tender's documents, but merely add to them. In the event of a contradiction between the provisions of the tender's documents and the rest of this announcement, tender's documents shall prevail.
8. Clalit is not obligated to accept the lowest bid or any bid. Clalit may at its sole discretion to accept the bid in all or in part or to split the tender among several bidders or to implement it in stages or cancel the tender, all as specified in the tender.
9. All other tender's conditions and procedure and the procedure for selecting the winning bid are detailed in the tender's documents, published on the Clalit's website, which may, from time, include updates regarding the tender at: www.clalit.co.il.
10. **The bids must be submitted in English by and no later than September 20th, 2016 at 12:00** (Israel time - GMT+2), via email, on the Sourcing Vision System, at address: <https://account.sourcingvision.com/login.aspx?ReturnUrl=%2fUser%2fMain.aspx%3f>. **For the purpose of submitting the bids through the system, each bidder has to register in advance.** Therefore, prior to the deadline of submission, all bidders must contact the Secretary of the Tender's Committee, Ms. Loren sweiry on the phone at ++972-3-6923580 and provide her with the relevant information which is required for registration. **A bidder that did not register will not be able to submit its bid through the system and its bid will be disqualified and will not be examined.**
